Our Crime

We are sinful criminals

We have disobeyed God's laws (Romans 3:23), and are unrighteous people (Romans 3:10). This makes us all guilty in the sight of God (Romans 3:19-20).

2 Our Condemnation

We are condemned to eternal death


We are condemned already before God, and worthy of eternal death (Romans 1:31). God's punishment for every sin is death (Romans 6:23).


Our Christ

Jesus Christ is our righteous substitute

Jesus came to take the charge of our sin upon himself (Romans 8:3), and he was punished for all our sin on the cross (Romans 5:8-9), past, present, and future (Romans 4:7-8), so that we could be counted as righteous in him (Romans 5:18-19; 3:26).

Our Conversion

We may be made innocent and righteous by faith alone

We can only be saved from our sin and be made innocent and righteous by acknowledging and believing in Christ (Romans 10:9-10). None of our works can make us righteous in God's sight (Romans 3:20); only faith alone can justify us (Romans 3:28; 4:5).

Our Confidence

We can never be condemned once we are in Christ

Once we are in Christ by faith, we can never be condemned for any sins we commit (Romans 8:1); this is because Christ died for us, rose for us, pleads for us, and prays for us (Romans 8:34).



How to Be *safe* in God

1

Our *D*arkness

We are lost and going in the wrong direction

We are all living dark lives which are the opposite of how Jesus lived (John 12:35), and this proves that we are blind and going the wrong way (John 3:19).

Our *D*estruction

We are going to perish eternally in our sin

Jesus warned that if we stay lost in our sins, and die in them, that we will "perish" eternally and be lost forever (John 8:24). Due to our sinful blindness, we cannot make it to heaven on our own.

3

Our *D*eliverer

We can only be rescued by Jesus

Jesus is the way to heaven (John 14:6). Jesus is the door that we must enter into to be rescued from our sin (John 10:9), because he gave himself for us (John 10:11). We are saved by what Jesus did for us, not by what we do for him (John 19:30).

Our *D*ecision

We must believe in Jesus to be rescued

We can only be rescued from eternal death by depending on Jesus in faith (John 3:16). We will fail to go to heaven only if we don't believe in Jesus (John 3:18). Believing in Jesus means to trust in him by coming to him (John 6:35) and looking to him in faith (John 6:40; 3:14-15).

Our *D*estiny

We can never be lost once we are rescued


Once we are found, we can never be lost again, because our souls are put into God's hand (John 10:28-29). Jesus promises that we will never be cast out for any reason once we come to him (John 6:37), and that he will lose no one who truly believes in him (John 6:39).



How to Get Rich Toward God

1 Our Poverty

We are spiritually poor slaves to sin, with an infinite sin-debt

By nature, we are impoverished sinners with a big sin-debt to God which grows every day (Romans 7:14-15). Our sinning has made us hopeless servants of sin (Romans 6:16); we have nothing good to offer and everything bad to receive.

2 Our Punishment


We will be sent to pay for our sin-debt forever in hell

Every sin we commit increases God's everlasting wrath against us (Romans 2:5-6), and soon we will all have to pay for our sins as God repays us with eternal death in hell (Romans 6:23).

3 Our Payment

Jesus paid our sin-debt on the cross with his own blood

Jesus sacrificed everything to come and redeem us from our sin (Philippians 2:6-8), and he paid the price of our redemption when he died for all of our sins on the cross (Ephesians 1:7). We can only be made spiritually rich through him (2 Corinthians 8:9).

4 Our Pardon

Our sin-debt can be forgiven by faith in Jesus' blood

We can be made spiritually rich by God's undeserved mercy and grace (Ephesians 2:4, 7). Salvation is a free gift which we do not, and cannot, earn (Ephesians 2:8). Our redemption comes by God's kindness (grace), not by our goodness (works) (Ephesians 2:9; Romans 11:6).

5 Our Prosperity

Believers can never be indebted or enslaved by sin again

Once we receive the gift of eternal life, God will never repent and take it back (Romans 11:29). Because we are saved by God's grace, we are secured by God's grace: the more sin we may do, the more grace God will give (Romans 5:20).



How to Become A Child of God

1

Our Alientation

We are dead in sin and in the family of the devil

We are all born as children of disobedience, and are alienated from God by our sins (Ephesians 2:1-2; 12). As unbelievers, our father is the devil, not God (John 8:44).

2 Our Abandonment

We are appointed to die eternally with Satan in his family


Satan will ultimately go to hell, so all of his children will go there too (Matthew 25:41). In our sin and unbelief, we are unable to inherit eternal life, and are sure to go to the lake of fire, if there is no record of our second birth (Revelation 20:15).

Our Atonement

Jesus took away the sin that alienated us from God

Jesus became a man and obeyed all of God's laws so that he could adopt us into God's family (Galatians 4:4-5). He suffered and died in order to pay the costs of our adoption (Hebrews 2:9-11).

Our Adoption

We can become a part of God's family by faith in Jesus

The only way to become a child of God is by faith in Jesus, the Son of God (Galatians 3:26). Once we believe in him, we are given the power to become God's children (John 1:12), and we are born again (John 3:3), by faith (1 John 5:1); heaven is inherited, not merited.

Our Allotment

God's children will share an eternal inheritance with Jesus


Once we become the children of God, we are promised an eternal inheritance in heaven that can never be lost (1 Peter 1:3-5). If a child of God sins, God punishes them on earth, but he does not disown them as his child (Hebrews 12:5-6).




How to Get Eternal Life from God


Our Disease

We are sick with a spiritual disease called sin

We have sinned grievously against God, and as a result are infected with a sin-disease (Isaiah 1:4); our sinful condition is getting worse and worse every day (Isaiah 1:5).

Our Danger

Our sinful disease is going to make us die eternally

Our sin is a terminal disease which we are ready to perish in (Isaiah 3:11). Because "the soul that sins shall die," there are no righteous works that we can do to heal us from our sin; our sin will end us down in hell (Isaiah 66:24).


Our Doctor

Only Jesus can heal us of our sin-disease

Jesus took our sin-disease upon himself (Isaiah 53:4), so that we could be spiritually healed and cleansed through his blood (Isaiah 53:5); Jesus and died for all of our sins (Isaiah 53:11).

Our Drug

We can be healed and saved from all sin by faith in Jesus

Only our faith in Jesus can make us spiritually healthy again (Isaiah 28:16). The moment we believe, we are spiritually cleansed of all our sin-disease (Isaiah 33:24), through the blood of the Lord (Isaiah 1:18). Our faith makes us whole (Mark 5:34).

Our Deliverance

We can never die eternally after we have trusted in Christ


After believing in Jesus Christ, we receive eternal life (John 6:47), and are immune to eternal death (John 11:25-26). Our sins can never cause us to die again (Isaiah 25:8), because we are saved with an everlasting salvation (Isaiah 45:17).




How to Have Peace with God

1

Our Partition

We are separated from God by our sin

Our sins have separated us from God (Isaiah 59:2-3), and have made us to be haters and enemies of God (James 4:4); there is a "middle wall of partition" between us and God.

Our Problem

We are in danger of eternal separation from God at death

God's wrath is against us for our sin (Romans 1:18), and if we die apart from God, we will be damned away from him forever in hell (2 Thessalonians 1:8-9).

Our Propitiation

Jesus took away the sin that made us at enmity with God

Jesus is the one and only mediator between us and God (1 Timothy 2:5), who took all of the wrath of God upon himself for all of our sins (1 John 2:2). Christ's blood makes peace between the holy God and sinful man (Ephesians 2:13-16).

Our Plan

We can have peace with God by simple faith in Jesus Christ

The only way to be reconciled to God and have access to him is by believing in Jesus (Romans 5:1-2), not by any "good" works that we do. Faith alone takes away God's wrath from us (John 3:36).

Our Peace

Once reconciled to God, we can never be separated from God

Because Jesus already took away all of God's wrath, after we are reconciled, there is nothing that is able to separate us from God's love (Romans 8:38-39). God's covenant of peace will never be removed from us (Isaiah 54:10).




How to Be Satisfied by God

We are exposed to eternal suffering in hell


We are all perishing in our sin, and if we die without having our spiritual needs met, we will eternally perish in hell, being tormented without any water or food (Luke 16:23-24).

Our **F**ood

Jesus is the only one who can provide for our spiritual need

Jesus is the living water that fills our thirst (John 4:10), the bread of life that fills our hunger (John 6:33), and the robe of righteousness that clothes our souls.

Our **F**eeding

We can be eternally satisfied only by faith in Jesus Christ

The one thing we must do to be revitalized and refreshed is to believe on Jesus (John 7:37-38). No works we do can satisfy our great need (John 6:28-29). We are freely and easily saved by partaking of Christ in faith (John 6:53-55).

Our **F**ulfillment

We can never spiritually hunger/thirst once we receive Jesus

After partaking of Christ by faith, we can never suffer eternally (John 6:35). Spiritually, we will never hunger again (John 6:50-51), and never thirst again (John 4:14), no matter how we live or behave. We shall never be eternally forsaken by God.



How to Get **Victory** with God


1 Our **H**indrance

We are captured by Satan and sin, and cannot win

In our war against sin, we have been taken captive by the devil in our sin, and are not able to deliver ourselves (Romans 7:23-24).

2 Our **H**arm

We are soon to be defeated by our sin and damned eternally

All those who are under the power of Satan will be damned with him forever (Matthew 13:41-42). As captives to sin, we are going to be cast into hell (Revelation 21:8).

3 Our **H**ero

Jesus Christ defeated the power of sin and Satan on the cross

Jesus came to die for the sins that ensnare us, and to defeat the devil (Hebrews 2:14). Jesus made it possible to recover us the devil by nailing our sins to his cross (Colossians 2:14-15); by his resurrection, Jesus defeated death, and overcame the world (1 Corinthians 15:55-57).

4 Our **H**ope


We can have victory over death and hell by faith in Jesus

The only way to overcome the world and be delivered from the punishment of sin is to believe in Jesus Christ (1 John 5:4-5). By faith in Christ, we are turned from the power of Satan to God (Acts 26:18), overcoming Satan by the blood of the Lamb (Revelation 12:11).

5 Our **H**aven

Once delivered, we can never ultimately be defeated by Satan


Overcomers by faith cannot experience the second death (Revelation 2:11), nor can they be blotted out of the book of life (Revelation 3:5). Believers in Christ are safe with Christ in the haven of heaven (Hebrews 6:18-19)



Our Blemish

We are spiritually defiled and undesirable

There is nothing attractive to God about us, but rather everything about our character is repulsive (Psalm 14:2-3). We are ignorant, blind, and wicked (Ephesians 4:18-19).

Our Barrenness

We will die without God forever in our unclean condition

Our shameful lives will end in a shameful eternity in hell (Romans 6:21). When you live as a spiritual whore you die as an eternal wretch (Revelation 19:2-3).

Our Bridegroom

Jesus loves us in spite of our sins, and gave himself for us

Jesus obeyed the commandments of the Father, and covered all of the necessary costs to marry us to himself by providing his own righteousness (Revelation 19:7-8). Jesus died to cleanse us from all of our filth (Ephesians 5:25-27), so God accepts us in Jesus (Ephesians 1:6).

Our Betrothal

We can be joined to Christ eternally only by faith in him

All things are now ready for anyone who wants to be saved, so we can be married to Christ freely (Revelation 22:17). It is by simple faith that we are united with Christ eternally, not by any complicated or difficult means (2 Corinthians 11:2-4).

Our Bond

Once we are married to Jesus, he will never divorce us

God hates divorce, so God promises that once we are married to him, he will never put us away (Matthew 19:6). God cannot lie (Titus 1:2), so God will never leave us nor forsake us, even if we sin again, because he will be faithful to his promise (2 Timothy 2:13).




